Sign Up Requirements:

- Current bill (phone, electric, etc.) or a lease that has the current name and address of the person signing up for the pantry.
- Photo ID of the person signing up for the pantry.
- Know your weekly, monthly, or annual household income.
- Sign up at your school district's assigned pantry during distribution hours. **Recipients must register at the food pantry within their school district.**
- **JULY is the beginning of our fiscal year. All households must re-register and supply the documentation listed above; expect longer than usual wait times.**
